Regular committed giving helps us to plan financially and to build a flourishing church that will endure for generations to come.




HOW YOUR REGULAR GIFT WILL MAKE A DIFFERENCE

A monthly gift by direct debit is the most effective way to give to the life and work of St Michael's. It helps us to budget and use resources wisely.



PARISH GIVING SCHEME

The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is the direct debit mechanism for planned giving which we encourage you to sign up to. It has benefits for both you and St Michael's, including you being able to change what you give at any time, or 'opt in' to increase your gift each year in line with inflation. It gives St Michael's predictable cash flow and an automatic way of collecting gift aid.
